Paediatric First Aid

Designed for:

Early Years Staff who look after children and babies in their workplace.

This course meets all the requirements and recommendations of the early years foundation stage {EYFS} for individuals employed or working in the early years sector.

Pre-Requisites

None Required

Duration of course:

12 Hours – Usually over 2 days. (Ofsted Requirement)

Aims and Objectives:

At the end of the session delegates will be able to competently deliver first aid to the standard required.

Course Content:

What to do in an emergency
Cardio – pulmonary resuscitation
First Aid for the unconscious child
First Aid for a child that is wounded or bleeding
Respiratory disorders
Convulsions
Injuries to bones muscles and joints
Burns and scalds

Qualification:

Delegates will receive a level 3 BFA award in Paediatric First Aid and Reference Manual. The award will be valid for 3 years.
